WHAT IS A BIOBLITZ?

This is an opportunity for scientists to engage and educate the public about the importance of biodiversity through hands-on experiences. During our School Day BioBlitz, scientist and volunteers from the public, like you and your students, will team up to explore the For-Mar property to identify as many species as possible. A wide variety of wildlife hikes, presentations, activities and live animal experiences will be held throughout the event; including frog, snake, plant, turtle and insect studies. More specific hike information will be available closer to the event.

This is a free For-Mar field trip opportunity that student groups can take part in between 10am—3pm and 4pm—6pm on Friday September 22nd. Some bus reimbursement is available on a first come, first served basis. Student groups can include, but are not limited to, public and charter schools, homeschool, scouting and afterschool groups.
