

## WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW FOR YOUR DAY OUT WITH THOMAS EXPERIENCE

Crossroads Village is handicap accessible. A wheelchair lift is used on the train cars and ramps are used to access the Genesee Belle. The exceptions are the 1912 Parker Carousel and the 1910 Parker Superior Wheel. A wheelchair swing is located adjacent to the 1910 Parker Superior Wheel at **no charge**.

A limited number of wheelchairs are available for guests at the Davison Depot, on a first-come, first-served basis, at **no extra charge**.

### Wheelchairs & Strollers

Free of charge and on a first-come, first-served basis. Wheelchairs and strollers can be picked up at the Davison Depot.

### Wagon & Stroller Parking

Wagons and strollers are not permitted on the train, the Genesee Belle or the second floor of the Colwell Opera House. Wagon and stroller parking is located at the Davison Depot, at the Genesee Belle dock, and outside the Colwell Opera House on Main Street.

### Lost & Found

Items may be dropped off at the General Store for recovery by their rightful owners.

### Designated Picnic Area

Outside food and beverages are allowed in designated picnic areas.

### First Aid Station & Guest Services

The First Aid Station and Guest Services are located in the Fowler Barber Shop on Main Street.

### Handicap Access to the Opera House Show

An elevator is located at the rear of the Crossroads Café for access to the second floor of the Colwell Opera House.

### #18, 19, 20 – 1912 Parker Carousel & 1910 Parker Superior Wheel and other vintage amusement rides

Tickets: \$1.25 each or 4 for \$4.00

**#21 Genesee Belle Paddlewheel Riverboat Tickets:** Adults \$3.00 and Children \$2.50. Tickets may be purchased at the front gate or at the 1912 Parker Carousel ticket booth. Boarding Times: 12 Noon, 1:00 pm, 2:00 pm, 3:00 pm, and 4:00 pm. (Please arrive 15 minutes before scheduled boarding time.)

## STEP BACK IN TIME — VISIT OUR HISTORICAL HOMES AND BUSINESSES

**#6 Fowler Barber Shop:** Listen to the Village gossip or play a game of checkers.

**#22 Blacksmith Shop:** Watch the blacksmith create a variety of tools and decorative items that are available for purchase.

**#27 Broom Shop:** Located in the Fenton Carriage Barn, the Village broom maker skillfully makes brooms, cake testers, pot scrubbers, veggie scrubbers, whisk and decorative brooms that may be purchased.

**#30 Toy Shop:** Visit the Village toy maker in the Durant Barn as wooden toys, miniature animals and much more are created. Toys may be purchased at the Toy Shop.

**#32 Print Shop:** Watch the Village printer use printing presses that printed the news during the time of President Lincoln and Harriet Tubman. Purchase Crossroads Village Christmas cards, notepads, bookmarks and thank you cards all printed and sold at the Village print shop.

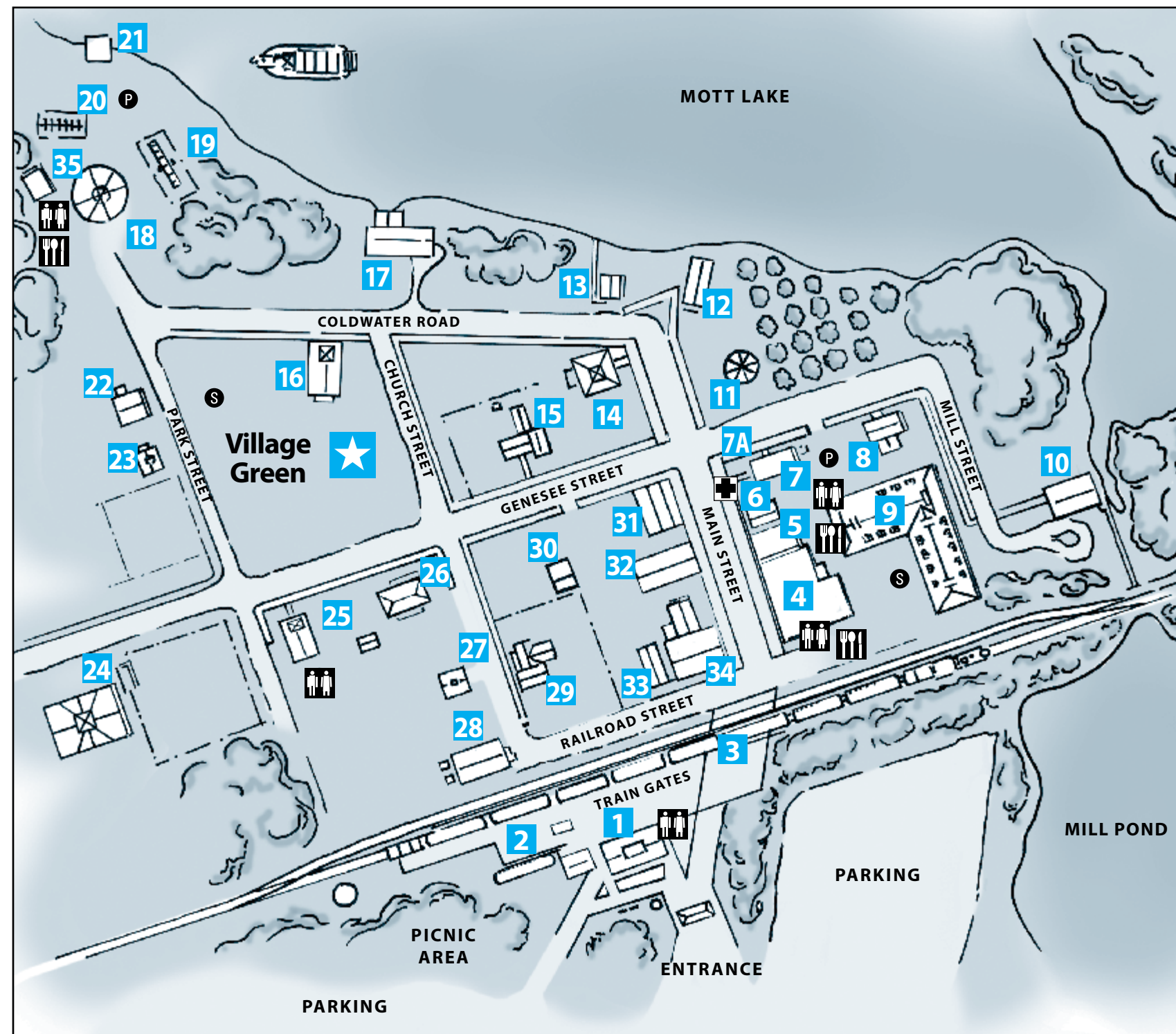
