

Bow-fishing and/or Spear-fishing Rules and Regulations

- Bow- fishing and /or spear-fishing will be permitted on Mott Lake only
- Bow-fishing and/ or spear-fishing will be permitted only on the area of Mott Lake east of Genesee Road and west of Vassar Road.
- Bow- fishing and /or spear-fishing will be permitted in the designated area(s) only from boats, not from shore
- All persons wishing to bow- fish and/or spear-fish in the designated areas must launch and remove their boat(s) from the Stanley Road boat launch and fishing site
- In addition to fishing license(s) required by the State of Michigan, all persons wishing to bow-fish and /or spear-fish in the designated areas must obtain a permit from the Genesee County Parks & Recreation Commission Park Ranger division. This permit must be presented on demand by a Genesee County Parks & Recreation Commission Park Ranger and/or other designated County Parks Official and /or law enforcement officer(s)
- The cost of a permit to bow- fish and /or spear-fish in the designated areas will be \$10 for Genesee County residents and \$20 for non-residents All permits will be valid during the bow fishing and /or spear-fishing season. are subject to the laws of the State of Michigan and the Genesee county Parks & Recreation Commission Park Rules
