Welcome to your Genesee County Parks!

Please read and observe these rules so that your stay here at Wolverine Campground will be safe and enjoyable for you and the other campers.

REGISTRATION – CHECK IN AND CHECK OUT

- Registration Building is open from 8 am to 10 pm.
- Check in time is 3 pm and check out time is 1 pm.
- Campsites may not be registered in an adult's name and left in the care of a minor.
- Only one (1) single family or four (4) unrelated persons allowed per site.
- One (1) camping trailer and one (1) tent or two (2) tents and no trailer are allowed per site.
- Registration of two (2) vehicles per site is included in the daily camping fee. There is a \$8 fee to change a vehicle registered to a campsite.
- Visitors must purchase an \$8 vehicle pass to enter the campground and all visitors must leave by 10 pm.
- Campers may not rent or reserve any one (1) campsite for a continuous time period exceeding 14 nights. However, a new camping permit may be issued if the campsite is available.
- Quiet hours are 11 pm to 7 am. Campers creating any noise or disruption that is a deterrent to the campground's harmony, quiet, and tranquility are subject to eviction during quiet hours.
- Guests under the age of 18 must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
- Gates are closed between Midnight and 5 am, and vehicles are prohibited from driving within the campground during that time, except for emergencies.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- Generators are not permitted.
- Wolverine Campground and Genesee County Parks can not be held responsible for power outages.
- No party type pole tents or stakes longer than 10 inches allowed. Fencing is prohibited.
- Fires are permitted only in fire rings, and are not to be unattended.
- Please dispose of your garbage at the dump station dumpsters.
- Cutting or removing any tree, tree branch, bush or shrub is prohibited, as is digging any trenches or making any excavation on any campsite.
- Cats/Dogs are welcome as long as they are leashed (6 foot maximum leash) and quiet. Cats/Dogs must be under the control of an adult camper and cannot be unattended at any time. Campers having a dangerous or noisy pet or failing to clean up pet excrement are subject to eviction.
- Swimming is only allowed in designated swimming areas at Buttercup Beach. **Absolutely NO swimming in the boat channel or from the lake-front sites at Wolverine Campground.**
- Purchase of a Genesee County Parks boat launch vehicle permit is required for the use of the boat launch at Wolverine Campground.
- Fireworks of any kind are prohibited.
- Electric Vehicles are prohibited from charging at electrical boxes.
- **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, MARIJUANA OR ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES ARE ALLOWED AT WOLVERINE CAMPGROUND. PARK RANGERS WILL ISSUE TICKETS TO VIOLATORS.**

Campers must abide by all Park Rules as adopted by the Genesee County Parks & Recreation Commission. Signing your receipt, when you check in, acknowledges that you agree to abide by these rules. Violation of rules may result in eviction from the campground. All evictions shall be for the duration of 2 camping seasons minimum.
