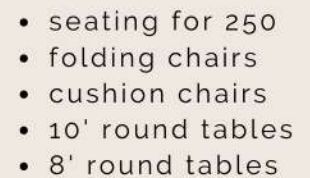
Whether you are looking to host an intimate gathering or rent out the entire village, we have custom pricing to fit your needs.

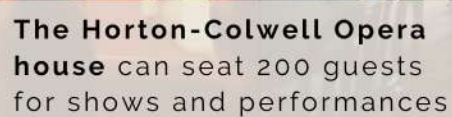
We also have a Chapel onsite that can seat 120 guests comfortably.

HUCKLEBERRY RAILROAD

The Huckleberry Railroad owns three locomotives, two cabooses, one hopper car, and a motor car (Speeder). Each and every coach, caboose, and car is unique in its origins and history.

Each 40-minute journey behind our authentic Baldwin steam locomotive takes you along the shores of Mott Lake, down a stretch of the historic Pere Marquette roadbed, and back into the heart of Crossroads Village.

The train also serves as a beautiful historic backdrop when not in use.

The train capacity is up to 400 persons.

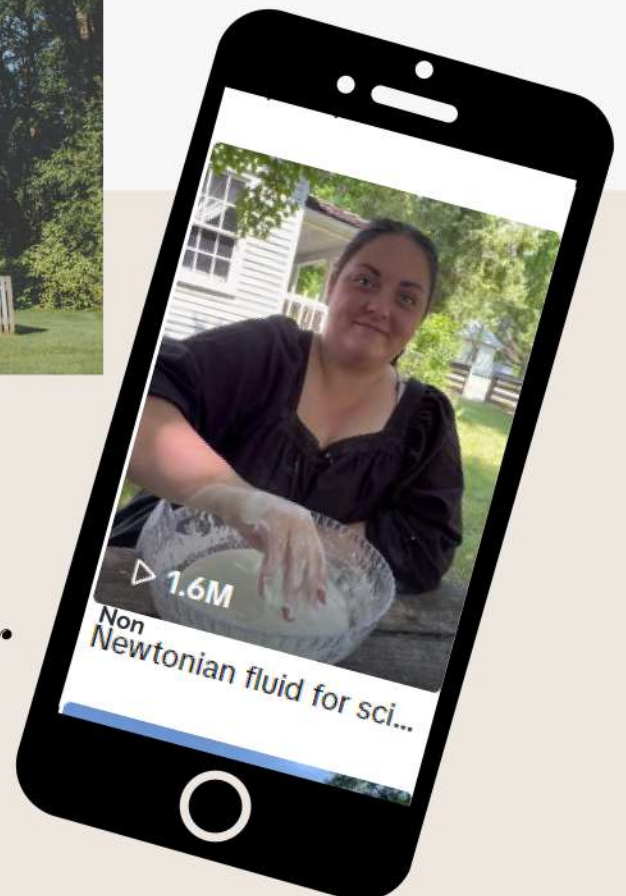

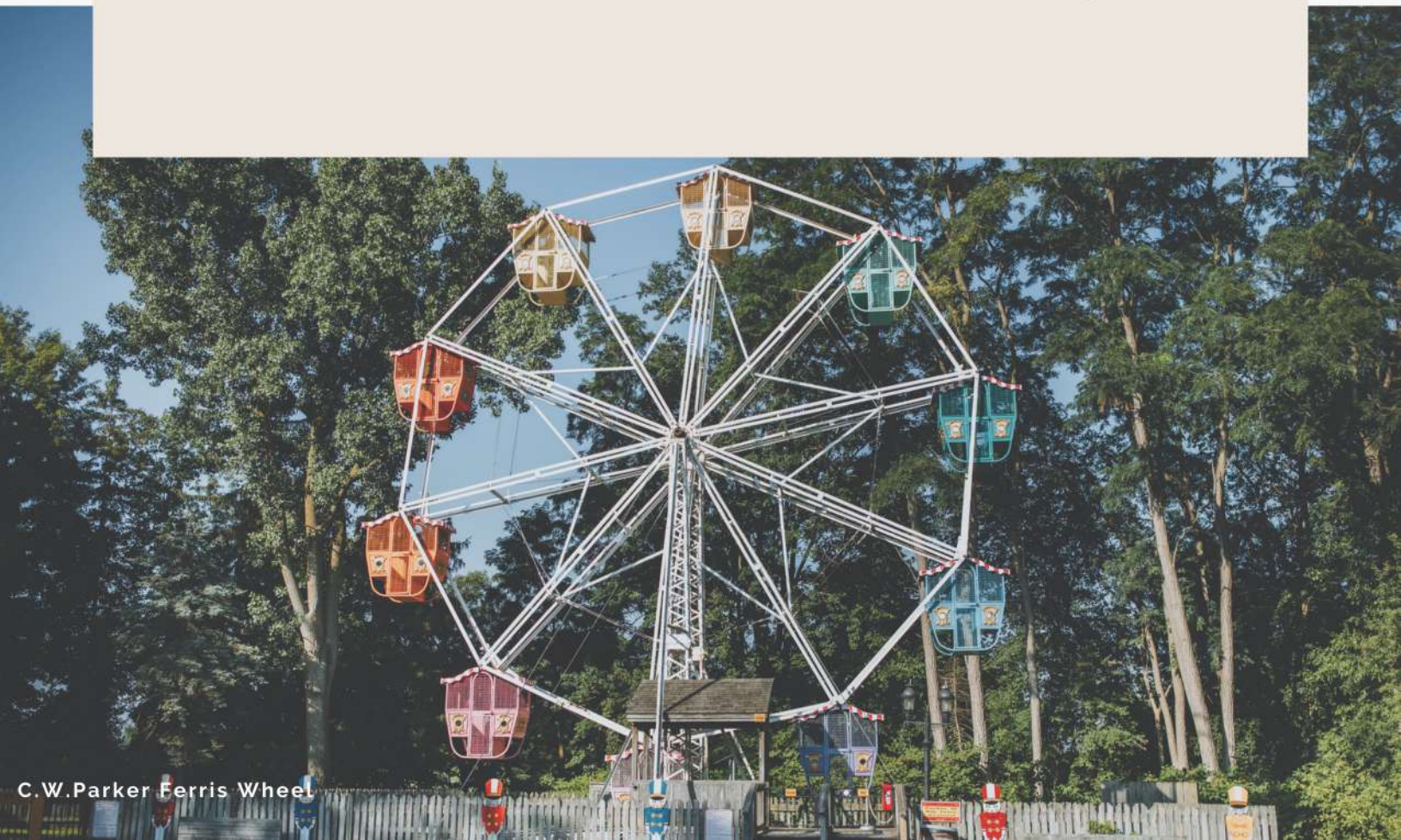

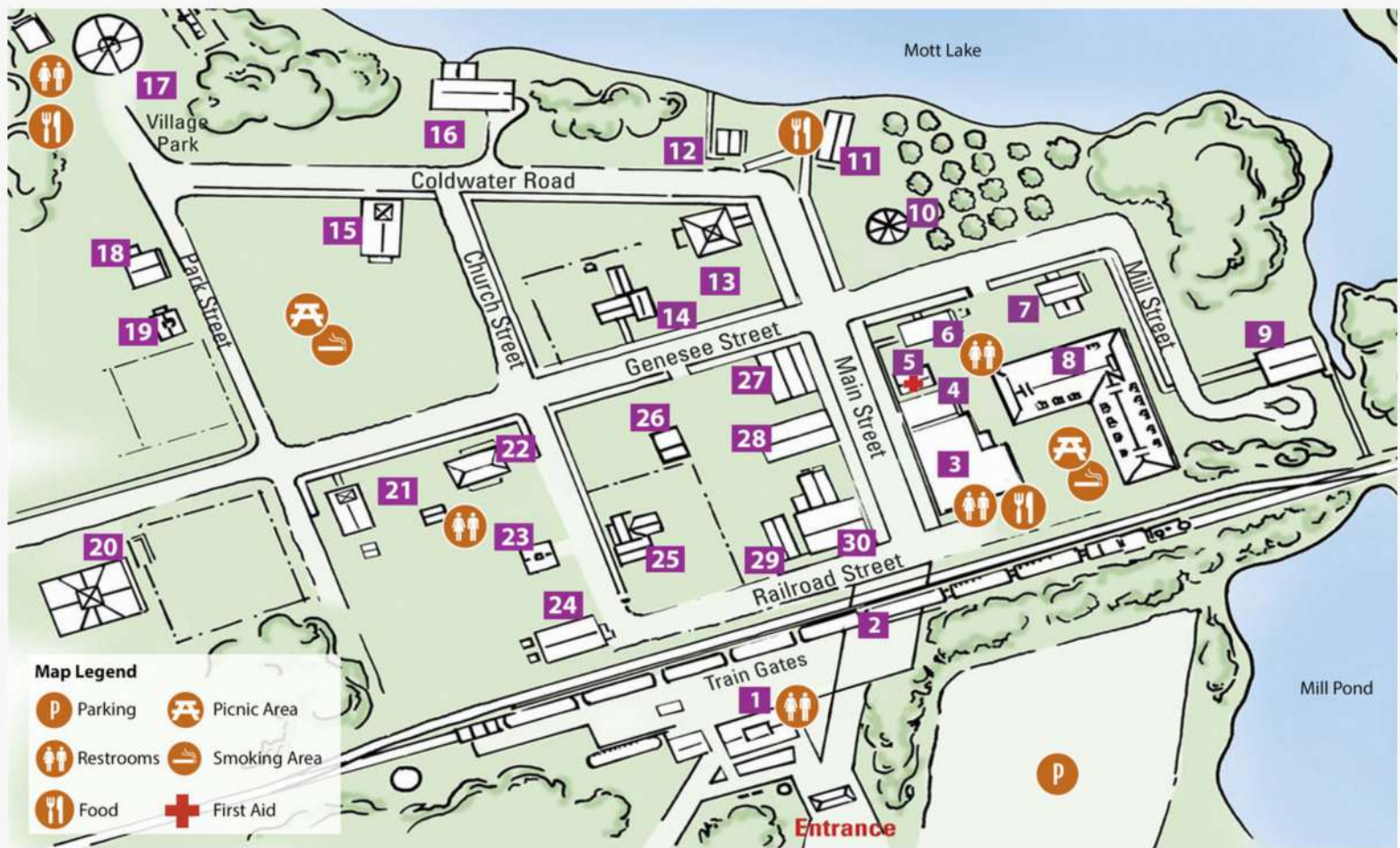
