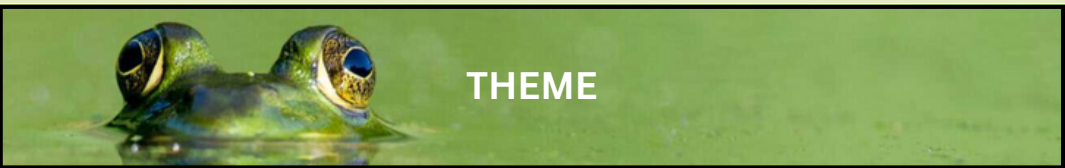

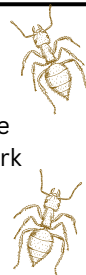

## Disclaimers / Fees



Space is limited, and is on a first come first served basis. Once the camp is full, a waitlist will be created. The waitlist does **NOT** guarantee enrollment.

A \$50 deposit per child per week is due to reserve your spot.  
 Full Payment is due two weeks before the start of the registered camp week.

A one-time Registration Fee of \$15 per camper is good for the entire summer and includes a camp t-shirt. Additional shirts can be purchased for \$10.

Prompt pickup of your child is important for our staffing requirements and therefore we have a \$10 fee for every 15 minutes late a child stays past 3pm. Repeat offenders may face consequences

**Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable to other weeks of camp.** Refunds/credits will not be issued for days or partial days missed. If the remaining balance due is not paid two weeks prior to the weekly camp start date, your spot and deposit may be forfeited. Registrations for day camp will end 2 weeks prior to the start of camp. Refunds or credits will not be issued for partial or full days missed.
