Requirements to be met for consideration of a Concession Permit:

- Submit the completed Concession Application & Required Documents MINIMUM 3 weeks prior to the date sales will begin.
- Required Documents to submit with Concession Application:
 - Copy of your valid Drivers License
 - Copy of your Michigan Sales Tax License
 - Copy of your Health Department Permit
 - \$40.00 Non-refundable Application Fee
 - Copy of your DBA/LLC
 - (Food Vendors) Copy of Menu
 - (Food Vendors) Picture of food truck/vehicle

• Final approval contingent upon:

- Successful criminal background check and/or drivers license check
- Submission of insurance certificate naming Genesee County as additional insured and proof of additional insured endorsement

Additional Information:

- Genesee County Parks accepts cash, check, or credit card. Checks should be made payable to: Genesee County Parks and Recreation Commission
- License fees must be paid in full prior to site setup.
- Approved applicant will be issued an identification badge that is to be carried/worn at all times while on Genesee County Parks property.
- Food Sales: Only pre-packaged food or drink may be sold without completing a Temporary Food Service License available from the Genesee County Health Department.
- The Concession/Vendor Agreement does not include the use of Commission buildings.
- Applications can be denied by the Genesee County Parks and Recreation Commission. Reasons may include, but are not limited to:
 - False statements made as part of the application process
 - Non-payment of fees
 - Revocation of a previous license
 - Conviction of a crime
 - Too many application for the same facility during the same time period
- Agreement may be terminated by the Genesee County Parks and Recreation Commission. Reasons may include, but are not limited:
 - Behavior that is adverse to the protection of the public health, safety or welfare of Genesee County Parks and Recreation Commission or park patrons
 - Special Events sponsored by the Genesee County Parks or any other organization requesting no outside vendor presence
 - Failure to wear or display the identification badge prominently
- Concessionaires must immediately and peacefully depart from the premises when requested to do so by Genesee County Parks or Law Enforcement officials.
- The identification badge remains the property of Genesee County Parks and Recreation Commission and must be surrendered upon request.
