
2025 PLANS BOAT LAUNCHES

- Explore potential of a fishing dock/walkway at Bluegill. Suggestion from UAW/future donation.

- Update dump station signage. (Cummings Center)
- Plant shade trees in fall near improved campsites. (Elba)

- •Identify funding sources to implement master plan with the help of Friends of For-Mar.





2025 PLANS HUCKLEBERRY RAILROAD

- Replace 200-300 railroad ties.
- Continue tamping ties & leveling rail.
- Start on ditch clean up with new tie crane, picking up dead trees along track from east loop to west loop.
- Install new 115# switch on main line to straighten track 5.
- Major restoration work to car 40.
- Start installing new couplers on cars.
- Build new berm, start laying new rail for track 5.
- Repair water tower.



THE MOUNDS

- Apply for Trail ORV grant for main roadway stone material.
- Improve trail conditions with winter, summer, and fall trail maintenance. Use of general staff labor, forestry mulcher, and brush hogging.
- Explore sponsorship opportunities.

WOLVERINE CAMPGROUND

- Completion of 1 ADA campsite.
- Complete final portion of Wi-Fi in Walker Way section.
- Installation of backup generators for registration and restroom facilities.
- Installation of a dock at the boat launch for easier lake access.
- Completion of a 30'x40' programming and recreation pavilion.
- Complete availability of campsite images during the online booking process.



WOLVERINE CAMPGROUND

- 2 ADA beach parking spaces with walkway to beach.
- Plant additional trees in park.
- Installation of 4 new shadow boxes at restrooms to better meet state posting requirements.



2025 PLANS WOLVERINE CAMPGROUND

- Update toilet paper and foaming hand soap dispensers for quality and efficiency.
- Update floors with textured epoxy where needed.
- Continue improving walking trail system with additional trails and directional signage.
- Update no hunting and park boundary signage around Wolverine property adjacent to Mt Morris, Baxter and pleasant view roads.
- Misc. painting of site posts, restroom trim, and dump station bollards.
- Update dump station signage.
- Installation of dock at boat ramp.



PARK RANGERS

- Ensure park safety through effective hiring, ongoing training, and strong leadership.
- Develop clear policies for the Park Ranger
 Division at Flint State Park, addressing unique
 challenges of an urban park.
- Improve nighttime security with visible patrols to deter vandalism and trespassing.
- Increase marine patrol operations and safety through training and effective hiring.






KEEP GENESEE COUNTY BEAUTIFUL

- Assist the City of Flint with the planning and implementation of capital improvement projects, park management, and long-term maintenance solutions.
- Collaborate and partner with local funders, community organizations, and residents to increase the use of Flint's public spaces through programming and events
- Plan and implement large scale cleanup events, including Stewardship Day in partnership with the Flint River Watershed Coalition
- Hire staff to take on City of Flint parks reservations and special event procedures
- Continue to recruit, train, and support volunteers working on public space projects

FLINT RIVER WATERSHED COALITION

- Continue integration of FRWC into the Genesee
 County Parks systems, including website, RecTrac, marketing, and finance.
- Assist the Friends of the Flint River Watershed with their transition to becoming a supporting organization.
- Increase connections to and relationships with the community with specific intent toward increasing diversity, equity, and inclusion.
- Seek additional funding for general operating and program support.
- Collaborate with GCP staff, departments, and programs on grants, construction projects, programs, and the State Park project.




2025 PLANS MARKETING

- Develop park sign library and map to aid in sign replacement.
- Work with DNR/State of Michigan to establish communication plans for the Flint State Park.
- Create Sponsorship opportunities/packets for Crossroads Village, For-Mar, and the Mounds.
- Invite large scale events to take place at Crossroads Village, and E.A. Cummings Center, as well as other park locations.
- Work with Explore Flint and Genesee to market our facilities.





- Replace Bluebell Beach bathhouse roof.
- Switch water service at Stepping Stone Falls from well to township water.
- Finish Richfield Park improvements along the Iron Belle Trail grant.
- Applied for grant to revisit pickleball courts at Linden County Park.
- Installation of back up generators at Administration office and garage.
- Connect missing section of trail at Bluebell Beach.
- Replacement of HVAC (multiple facilities).
- Continue LED light upgrades.
