False statements made as part of the application process
Non-payment of fees
Revocation of a previous license
Conviction of a crime
 Too many application for the same facility during the same time period
• Agreement may be terminated by the Genesee County Parks and Recreation Commission. Reasons may include, but are not limited:
 Behavior that is adverse to the protection of the public health, safety or welfare of Genesee County Parks and Recreation Commission or park patrons
 Special Events sponsored by the Genesee County Parks or any other organization requesting no outside
vendor presence
Failure to wear or display the identification badge prominently
 Concessionaires must immediately and peacefully depart from the premises when requested to do so by Genesee County Parks or Law Enforcement officials.
• The identification badge remains the property of Genesee County Parks and Recreation Commission and must be surrendered upon request.
